**ORDER APPROVING JUDGMENT
DISTRIBUTION PLAN (DKT. 188)**

Judgment was entered in favor of Plaintiff, Marc Guisinger and the Class certified by the Court, and against Defendant Keystone RV Company (“Keystone”), pursuant to Rule 68 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure effective June 4, 2026.

Pending before the Court is the parties’ joint stipulation and proposed Judgment Distribution Plan. *See* Dkt. # 188. The Court hereby **ADOPTS AND APPROVES** the parties’ Judgment Distribution Plan as fair, reasonable and adequate, and **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Epiq Class Action and Claims Solutions, Inc. (“Epiq”) is appointed as Judgment Administrator;
2. The Judgment Notice and Requests for Payment set forth in the parties’ joint stipulation and the proposed forms of Notice attached as Exhibits 1 and 2 to that stipulation are hereby approved;
3. The Court adopts the following schedule for the Judgment Distribution Plan:

EVENT	DATE
Epiq shall complete the direct mailing and summary notice publishing	July 24, 2026
Requests for Payment and supporting documentation from Class Members with wood trusses	August 28, 2026
Epiq to complete distribution of \$2,000 direct payments to qualifying Class Members submitting valid Requests for Payment and supporting documentation	October 2, 2026
Final day for qualifying Class members to cash direct payment checks	December 31, 2026
Keystone shall submit to the Court its declaration accounting for payments to qualifying Class members	February 5, 2027

4. Keystone is responsible for all post-judgment costs, including all costs associated with the Judgment Distribution Plan; and
5. Plaintiff is directed to file either a Notice of Satisfaction of Judgment or identify any portion of the Judgment that remains unsatisfied by February 19, 2027.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
