

NOTICE OF JUDGMENT IN CLASS ACTION

A JUDGMENT IN A CLASS ACTION AFFECTS YOUR RIGHTS AND MAY ENTITLE YOU TO RECEIVE \$2,000.00.

KEYSTONE'S RECORDS SHOW THAT YOU PURCHASED A NEW PASSPORT BRAND WESTERN EDITION TRAILER FROM A KEYSTONE AUTHORIZED DEALERSHIP IN CALIFORNIA BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2019, THAT MAY HAVE BEEN CONSTRUCTED WITH WOOD ROOF TRUSSES INSTEAD OF STEEL ROOF TRUSSES.

THIS JUDGMENT NOTICE EXPLAINS HOW TO CLAIM YOUR \$2,000.00 PAYMENT FROM KEYSTONE BY SUBMITTING A REQUEST FOR PAYMENT AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION.

*A federal court authorized this notice. This is not a solicitation from a lawyer.
Please read this Notice carefully and in its entirety.*

- A class action lawsuit known as *Guisinger v. Keystone RV Company*, Case No. 2:23-cv-01393-MWC-RAO (the "lawsuit"), was pending in the United States District Court for the Central District of California (the "Court") against Defendant Keystone RV Company ("Keystone").
- The lawsuit alleges that Keystone began manufacturing its Western Edition Passport Travel Trailers with wood roof trusses after September 2016 while representing the trailers were manufactured with "5 [inch] Crowned / Stamped Galvanized Steel Roof Trusses" until December 2019. Keystone denies Plaintiff's legal claims.
- You were identified in Keystone's records as a Class member because you are a consumer who purchased a new Passport Brand Western Edition Trailer from a Keystone authorized dealership in California before December 1, 2019, with a Serial Number that sequentially ends after HX414101 ("Class Trailer").
- Judgment has been entered in favor of Plaintiff and the Class for all Class members who currently own Class Trailers with wood roof trusses. The Judgment entitles each such Class member with wood trusses, who submits a valid Request for Payment with supporting documentation, to \$2,000.00.
- If you submit a valid Request for Payment and acceptable supporting documentation, the Judgment Administrator will send you a check for \$2,000.00 in satisfaction of this Judgment. If you do not submit a Request for Payment or acceptable supporting documentation, you will not receive the \$2,000.00. If your Class Trailer has metal roof trusses, you will not receive the \$2,000.00.
- **Your legal rights are affected whether you act or don't act. Read this notice carefully.**

BASIC INFORMATION

1. Why did I get this notice?

Keystone's records show that you purchased a new Passport Brand Western Edition Trailer from a Keystone authorized dealership in California before December 1, 2019, with a Serial Number that sequentially ends after HX414101. You were previously notified that you were a member of the certified class. The Judgment in your favor and against Keystone was entered in the United States District Court for the Central District of California in *Guisinger v. Keystone RV Company*, Case No. 2:23-cv-01393-MWC-RAO.

The Honorable Michelle Williams Court of the United States District Court for the Central District of California is overseeing this class action.

2. What is this lawsuit about?

The lawsuit alleges that Keystone manufactured its Passport Brand Western Edition Trailers with a Serial Number that ends after HX414101 with wood roof trusses while representing the trailers were manufactured with "5 [inch] Crowned / Stamped Galvanized Steel Roof Trusses" until December 1, 2019. Because Keystone's representation is alleged to be false, Plaintiff asserts legal claims against Keystone under: (1) the California Consumers Legal Remedies Act, (2) California Unfair Competition Law, (3) California False Advertising Law, and (4) common law unjust enrichment.

Keystone denies Plaintiff's legal claims and denies any wrongdoing. Keystone contends that some Class Trailers have metal roof trusses, not wood roof trusses as alleged in the lawsuit. To recover under the Judgment, the Class Trailer must have wood roof trusses.

3. What was the result of the lawsuit?

The Court ruled in February 2026 that this lawsuit should proceed as a class action. Notice was provided to you in May 2026, and you did not ask to be excluded from the lawsuit by June 22, 2026. On June 23, 2026, the Court entered Judgment in your favor as a Class member and against Keystone for \$2,000.00, provided that you currently own the Class Trailer and it has wood roof trusses.

On June 30, 2026, the Court approved the Judgment Plan of Distribution, allowing you to submit a Request for Payment and supporting documentation for your \$2,000.00 Judgment from Keystone.

4. How do I receive my \$2,000.00 Judgment?

To receive payment, you must complete the Request for Payment included with this Judgment Notice or available at www.KeystonePassportClassAction.com, and submit supporting documentation with the Request for Payment. The Request for Payment and supporting documentation must be submitted to the Judgment Administrator at www.KeystonePassportClassAction.com or postmarked on or before **August 28, 2026**, and mailed to:

After **August 28, 2026**, you can no longer submit a Request for Payment or supporting documentation or collect your \$2,000.00 Judgment.

Keystone reserves the right, in good faith, to dispute the sufficiency of a submission regarding whether a Class Trailer has wood roof trusses. If Keystone disputes your Class Trailer ownership based on its records, you may be asked to submit additional proof of ownership. If Keystone disputes that your Class Trailer has wood roof trusses based on its records, you may be required to establish wood roof truss construction through video or photographs of an exposed wood truss accessed in your Class Trailer by removing the screws from the bathroom vent and conducting a visual inspection of the trusses, which can be completed in approximately 20 to 25 minutes. A Class Trailer with metal roof trusses is not entitled to the \$2,000.00 direct payment and need not submit a Request for Payment. False statements may result in denial of your claim and may subject you to penalties.

5. Is there any money or benefits available now?

If your Request for Payment and supporting documentation is valid and timely, the Judgment Administrator will mail you a check for \$2,000.00 on or before October 2, 2026.

If you do not submit a Request for Payment or provide supporting documentation by **August 28, 2026**, you will not receive a check for \$2,000.00.

If your Class Trailer has metal roof trusses, you will not receive the \$2,000.00 and need not submit a Request for Payment.

If you submit a Request for Payment, you are required to provide a completed IRS Form W-9 (or other appropriate tax documentation) as a condition of receiving payment. Payments may be reported to the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") on IRS Form 1099 (including, as applicable, Form 1099-MISC or Form 1099-NEC). The failure to timely provide required tax information may result in withholding or delay of payment.

You should understand that any and all payments made pursuant to the Judgment in this lawsuit may be taxable under applicable federal, state, and/or local laws. If you receive and accept payment pursuant to a Request for Payment, you are agreeing to be solely responsible for all federal, state, and/or local tax liability arising from the receipt of the payment, including any interest or penalties associated with such tax liability. You are also agreeing that you will not look to, nor seek from Epiq or Keystone, compensation for any tax liability or related costs.

You should understand that the statements contained herein do not constitute tax or legal advice concerning the payment(s) described herein, and that you are advised to seek independent tax and/or legal advice regarding the tax consequences of any such payment(s).
